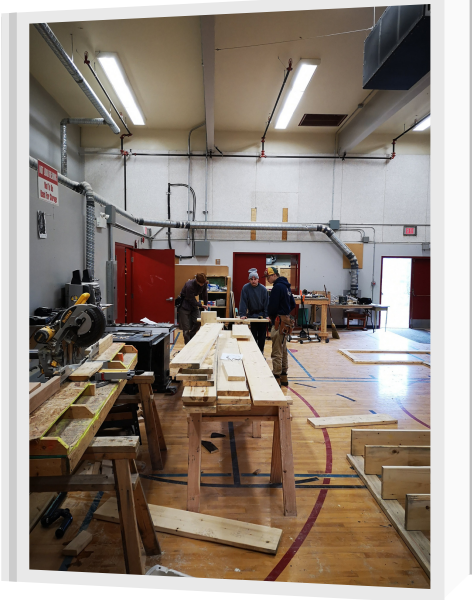

## PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Students are immersed in the "Level One" Carpentry curriculum where they learn the basics of constructing a wood frame structure from the bare ground to the roof top.

Students learn both theoretical knowledge and practical application of skills and concepts related to the trade.

- The student satisfies graduation requirements and successfully graduates.
- The student successfully completes "Level One" technical training.
- The student becomes indentured as an official apprentice to a community based employer in a trade of their choice.

- Graduates of this program enter the workforce as registered apprentices with great earning potential in the industry.
- Students who successfully complete their work courses may qualify for a \$1,000 Scholarship.
- Successful graduates may progress to Level 2, Level 3 and Level 4, and earn Red Seal certification, which provides national recognition.
